As we look back over 2009, we first have to say, THANK YOU. We recognize, as always, that the work we do is done only with your partnership. Whether you've given time, money or offered prayers for the people of Haiti – thank you.

We understand that this year has brought hardships to many individuals, families and communities. And we are grateful that despite the difficult times, Haiti Foundation of Hope has not had to cut back its support for any of the ongoing programs in Terre Blanche, Haiti.

The school continues to grow. This year there are 920 students, including 200 children in pre-kindergarten, who are learning and receiving healthy meals. The community health program is taking shape, volunteer medical teams have been working alongside Haitian co-workers at the Clinic of Hope, women are learning life-changing skills at the women's trade school, and people are receiving assistance through micro-loans and the clean water project.

We look to 2010 with hope. We look forward to continuing our partnership with you as we address the physical, emotional and spiritual needs of the people living in rural northern Haiti. We look forward to making a difference and seeing lives changed.

SCHOOL BOOKS



Haiti Foundation of Hope supports a school for pre-kindergarten, primary and secondary students in Terre Blanche, a village in rural northern Haiti. The school has 920 students and a staff of caring teachers and administrators. In addition to classroom learning, students receive lunch - typically rice and beans - every day and for many of them it is their only meal. For most of the students, the fees for books, uniforms and meals are impossible for their families to afford, and it is only with your help that they are able to continue their studies. The school is just one of many ongoing projects supported by Haiti Foundation of Hope and yet it makes up 50 percent of the budget. Please consider how you might financially join with us in providing learning and healthy meals to these children.
