Thank you for being a part of Haiti Foundation of Hope! At the end of the year, we look back and see the many things that have been accomplished and are appreciative of your participation. We remain committed to our partners in Haiti and rely on you to keep our partnership strong. Much has been accomplished in Haiti, yet much remains to be done.

SOME 2015 HIGHLIGHTS

10™ ANNIVERSARY! – We celebrate ten years as a non-profit organization this year!

COMMUNITY HEALTH – A midwife has strengthened the clinic and community health program. An annual survey recently revealed that a number of improvements have been made in health and education due to the Community Health Program. Some of these improvements are greater knowledge of HIV and tuberculosis, higher vaccination rates, decreased malnutrition, and better prenatal and antenatal care.

AGRICULTURE – A drip irrigation system has been introduced in Terre Blanche, which allows for crops to grow despite drought conditions.

SCHOOL – A student, Abel Joseph, has completed his education at Terre Blanche and is now the first from the area to consider going to college.

CLINIC – A surgery room has been completed and is equipped with an air conditioner, making it possible for a visiting Haitian ophthalmologist to do 14 cataract surgeries in one day. Our 5th annual Medical Conference drew 115 attendees from many parts of Haiti. There are over 50,000 registered patients and 97,000 total visits to the clinic in 8 years.

ECONOMIC – Local women of Terre Blanche are making jewelry and selling it on their own.

ONGOING FINANCIAL NEEDS

STAFF SUPPORT – Additional staff support is needed for the school and clinic.

FOOD – Rice and beans are needed to continue the school lunch program that provides daily lunches to every student.
