GREATEST NEED

Gift 1: Any amount to greatest need

The needs are great. Your donation will be used where it's needed the most.

CLINIC OF HOPE

Gift 2: Support the staff - \$100

Support the Clinic of Hope staff, including doctor, nurses, midwife, lab technician, pharmacist, chaplain and administrators.

COMMUNITY HEALTH

Gift 3: Volunteer training - \$60

Provide training for a volunteer with the Community Health Program.

While the *Clinic of Hope* continues to see patients throughout the year, the *Community Health Program* is mobilizing, training and supporting local volunteers to reduce deaths from maternal complications, tuberculosis and HIV, as well as diarrhea, pneumonia and malnutrition among children.



EDUCATION

Gift 4: School lunches - \$25

Feed 100 students for a day.

Gift 5: Books for students - \$50

Provide books for 10 students.

Gift 6: Student uniforms - \$75

Provide uniforms for 5 students.

Gift 7: Teacher salary - \$125

Support a teacher for one month.

Gift 8: Primary student - \$15

Support a primary school student for one month.

Gift 9: Secondary student - \$25

Support a secondary school student for one month.

The *school* in Terre Blanche has nearly 1,000 students in pre-kindergarten through 12th grade. Lunch is served every day, and the teachers are caring and encouraging.



FOOD DISTRIBUTION

Gift 10: Rice and beans - \$50

Purchase a bag of rice or beans and provide food for those most in need.

WOMEN'S TRADE SCHOOL

Gift 11: Teacher salary - \$125

Support the trade school teacher for one month.

Gift 12: Sewing machine - \$300

Purchase a treadle sewing machine to be given to a graduate of the trade school.

The *Women's Trade School* is a three-year program that offers women an opportunity to learn skills such as sewing, cooking, child development, nutrition, health and etiquette.
