Finding vision in Terre Blanche

Team members seek to find ways of involvement in Haiti

Eleven people traveled to Terre Blanche in June for what has been called the first "Vision Team" with Haiti Foundation of Hope. While previous teams have focused on meeting medical needs, this team was comprised of people seeking a deeper level of understanding of the work in Terre Blanche. They used the trip as an opportunity to see how they might become involved long term given their talents and interests.

The team had a unique opportunity to interact with people from Terre Blanche at a personal level and also gained a broad exposure to the many projects supported by Haiti Foundation of Hope. Some time was spent working in the medical clinic, but each team member also visited the school, watched bio-sand water filters being made and installed, and learned about the feeding program for school children.

The team also received updates about the implementation of a community health program and saw new homes and foundations that were being built following the severe flooding in last year's hurricane season. Two team members spent a lot of time listening to locals involved with a micro-loan program with the hope of increasing the foundation's involvement in economic development.

Time was spent traveling to other nearby villages to gain an appreciation for what

can be done in the surrounding area.

A highlight of the team's time in Terre Blanche was a concert by Justin Klump, a talented young musician who was part of the team. The concert drew a crowd of about 500 people and was yet another way for the larger community to come together and celebrate all that is being accomplished in the area.

It has been exciting to see how Haiti Foundation of Hope has established partnerships with people to address the needs of those living in Terre Blanche.

We are meeting spiritual needs through a thriving church community which is now constructing a new church building; medical needs through the Clinic of Hope and the new community health program; physical needs through clean water and food for children; education needs through a primary and secondary school and a women's trade school; and economic needs through local micro enterprise.

We are truly grateful for the tremendous support shown by our donors, volunteers and supporters, and look forward to all that is in store for the future.
