I've been going to Terre Blanche for over 20 years and I remember when there was no school for children. I remember when families had no education in this remote area of Haiti.

I remember children standing around and watching us work – children without shoes, without education.

Today, there are almost 1,000 students enrolled in school and parents often cry if they cannot get their children into the school. With the work of Haiti Foundation of Hope and your donations, there is now a pre-kindergarten, primary and secondary school.

Children continue to receive a daily lunch and some students are now studying in the universities of Haiti.

Students are beginning to use computers and have dreams of becoming doctors, nurses. engineers, and teachers. One young lady says she to be wants

My heart is overwhelmed as I watch these kids grow up and think back to 20 years ago. People ask if Haiti is changing and I always respond with a resounding, "Yes! The area around Terre Blanche is changing – there is education; there is Hope!"

The number of students passing government exams in Haiti is about 20 percent. The number of students passing government exams in Terre Blanche is more than 90 percent.

This year Alfreno, an alumnus of the high school and now a university student, decided to give back to his alma mater in appreciation of the quality education he received at Terre Blanche.

Searching diligently for donations and grants, he was able to get used government computers donated to Terre Blanche. But it didn't end there. Working with the school, he set up a computer lab at the Terre Blanche school.

I always thought that someday we would see a return on the investment in Terre Blanche and here it is happening already.
